



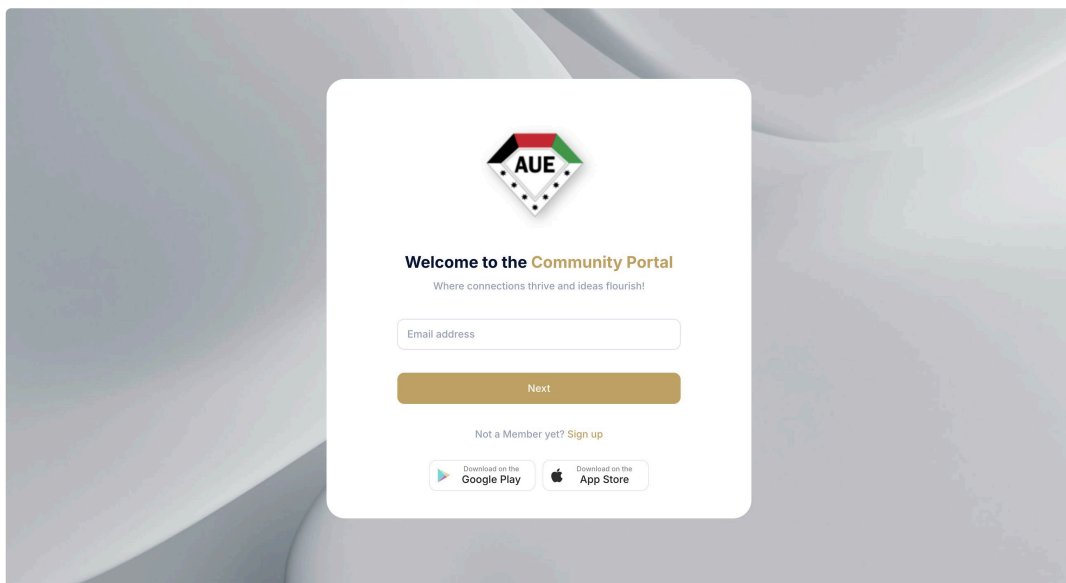

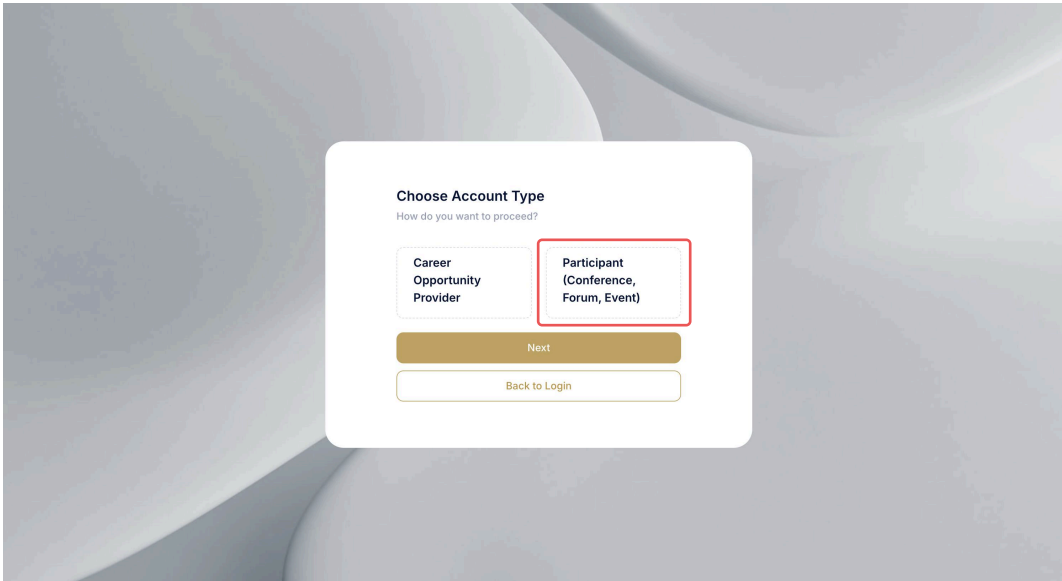

Login Procedure

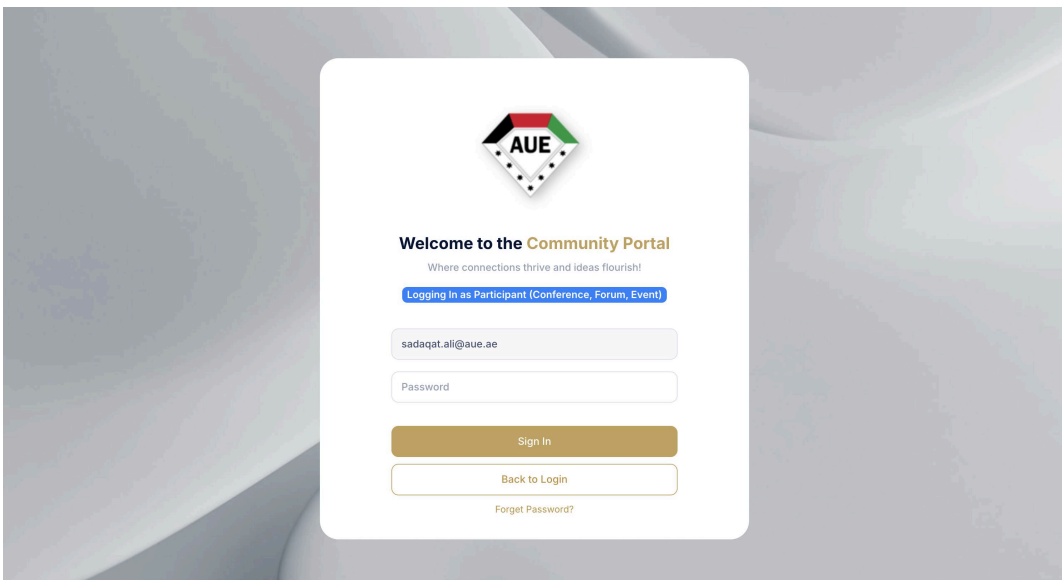
 **Step 1 : Navigate to <https://community.aue.ae> and enter your credentials to log in to the system.**



 Step 2 : Select "Participant" as the user role and continue.

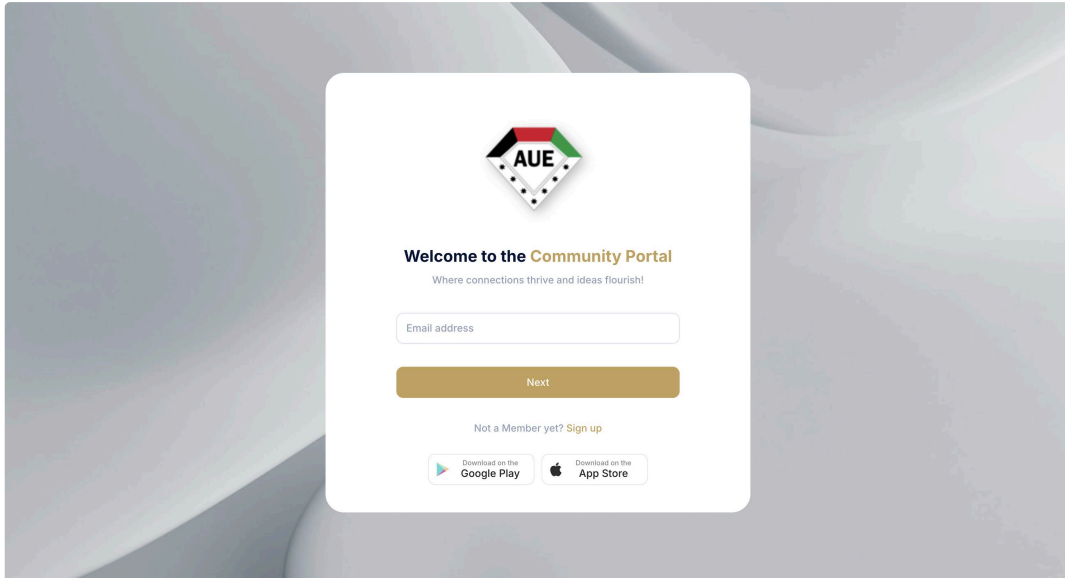


 Step 3 : Enter the password as "Participant" and sign in.

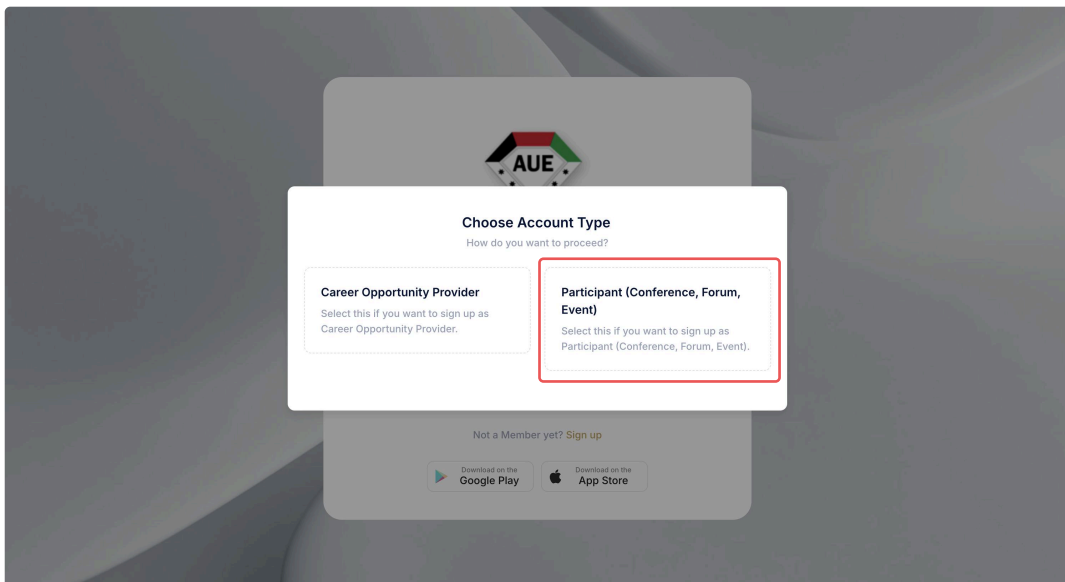


Step 1: Navigate to <https://community.aue.ae> and click Sign Up to create a new account as a new user.

 Step 3: Fill in your details and click Register.



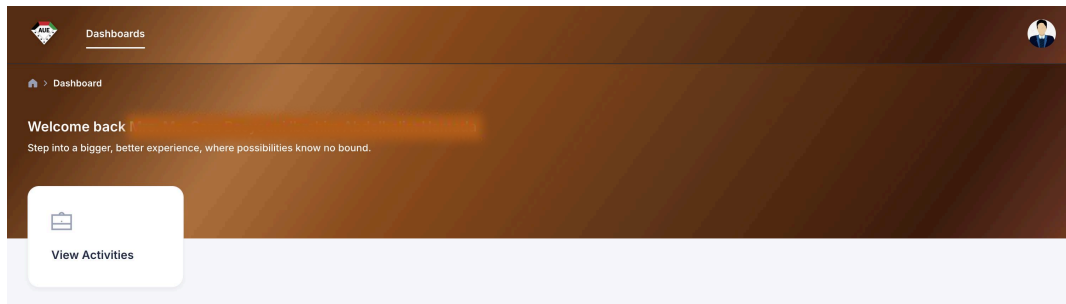

Main Dashboard

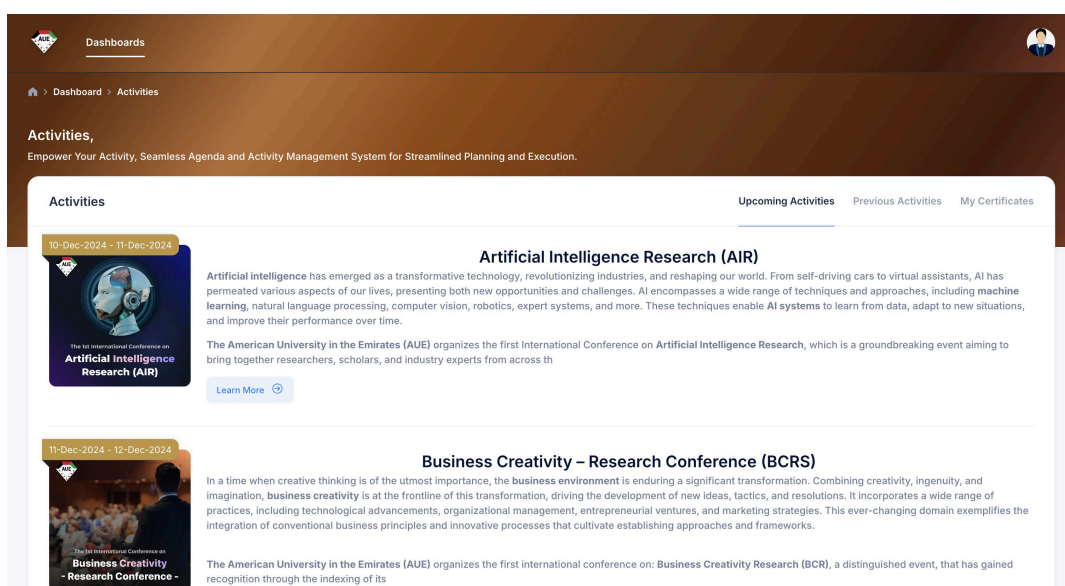
